## Transportation

Santa Clara is served by three major airports: San Jose, San Francisco and Oakland.

[San Jose Airport \(SJC\)](#). SJC is typically the most convenient option. It has many non-stop flights and is 10 minutes from campus and the conference hotels.

There is a free shuttle ([The VTA/SJC Airport Flyer](#)) that makes a continuous loop between the Santa Clara Caltrain Station, which is located next door to the Candlewood Suites, and the airport terminals. Shuttles run every 15-30 minutes from 5:00am to 11:30pm.

[San Francisco Airport \(SFO\)](#). SFO has more flights than SJC, but it's not always a better choice. First, it has more weather delays than SJC due to outdated runways and its prime fogbelt location. Second, SFO is busier and larger than SJC, so getting in and out of the airport usually takes longer. Finally, its distance from campus—about 40 miles/45 minutes (depending on traffic)—means extra post-flight travel time and expense. Ground transportation options include:

- Uber/Lyft (approx. \$67 plus tip)
- Taxi (approx. \$125 each way plus tip)
- Pre-arranged car service (approx. \$110 each way plus tip)
- Shared ride service, such as SuperShuttle (approx. \$45 each way plus tip)
- Car rental (note: it takes about 10 minutes to get from the airport terminals to the car rental center)
- Mass transit (to get to campus, take [BART](#) to Millbrae (\$4.40), then switch to [Caltrain](#) and take it to the Santa Clara stop; approx. \$8). The train station is right across the street from campus and next door to one of the conference hotels, [Candlewood Suites](#). This option isn't popular with locals; it takes about 90 minutes to get to campus.

[Oakland Airport \(OAK\)](#). OAK and SJC generally have the same flight options, but OAK has a few non-stop options that SJC doesn't have (see <http://www.oaklandairport.com/airlines/route-map/>) OAK is about 40 miles/45 minutes from campus, and ground transportation options/costs are about the same as SFO's (but mass transit is even less attractive).

## Hotels

We have made arrangements with both the [Candlewood Suites-Santa Clara](#) and [The Fairmont San Jose](#) to provide a discounted room rate for attendees of the Content Moderation and Removal at Scale Conference. A limited number of rooms are available on a first-come, first served basis.
